ECDL WEB EDITING & IMAGE EDITING VERSION 2.0 TESTS

ECDL Malta has just launched the new syllabi (V2.0) for ECDL Web Editing and ECDL Image Editing.

ECDL Web Editing (formerly known as ECDL WebStarter) is a certification programme that enables candidates to acquire the skills and knowledge required to design, create and maintain a website. By explaining the basics and defining terms in a straightforward way, candidates will understand the key concepts underpinning web editing and publishing, in addition to acquiring a wide range of web design skills, from basic HTML to image manipulation.

ECDL Image Editing (formerly known as ECDL ImageMaker) is a certification programme that enables candidates to acquire the skills and knowledge required to manipulate and prepare images for printing or for publishing on the web. By explaining the basics and defining all terms in a straightforward way, candidates will understand the key concepts underpinning image editing, and will have the skills to produce high-quality formatted digital images.

The recommended training is 20-30 hours for each of these modules.

Until 31st July 2011, candidates can sit for Web Editing & Image Editing tests on both the old and the new syllabi at various Test Centres. ECDL Web Starter V1.5 and ImageMaker V1.5 tests will not be available as from 1st August 2011. The certificates issued by ECDL Malta will reflect the syllabus version of the test.
